Applications will be scored and ranked. Scholarship award priority will be based on application score.

Scholarship Rules

- Applicants must be a new or returning PTCC student with a declared PTCC major or partnership program.
- Applicants must complete the application, essay questions and reference. Due by July 8, 2016. No Exceptions.
- Full-time students must be registered for at least 12 credits and Part-time for at least 6 credits
- Distribution of funds will be made by the Business Office upon approval of Foundation Board. If you have a balance due on your student account the scholarship will be credited to your account. If not, refunds will be distributed the end of the second week of fall semester.
- Students receiving a scholarship will be required to send a thank you letter to a Foundation donor. Instructions will be mailed to the student. The letter must be returned to the President's Office by August 26, 2016. Recipients will also be asked to attend a donor recognition event on October 21, 2016.

Hints and Tips

- **Follow all instructions. Strong applications must be typed and carefully proofed.**
- Proof, proof, proof. Typos and grammatical errors will result in a lower score. Have someone read your application before you turn it in.
- Touch on your achievements, field of study, future goals, and challenges in your essay. Successful applications typically include a paragraph on each key element.
- Organize your thoughts and ideas. Re-read to be sure you are addressing all aspects of the questions.
- Contact your reference early to provide time to complete their form. *Relatives are not acceptable references.*
- Submit all forms: Application, Essays, and Reference.
