



Motorcycle Basic & Intermediate Rider Courses

Basic Rider Course 14.5 Hours \$245

PTCC offers high quality professional training and education. Our instructors are certified by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) and dedicated to building and improving your riding skills.

The MSF Basic e-Course is a highly interactive 3-hour online program that provides riders of all skill levels with the basics of motorcycling. The e-Course is a requirement that prepares you for the 4.5 hours of activity bases classroom exercises, and the 10-hours of hands-on riding exercises.

On the riding range, your MSF certified RiderCoach will guide you through the basic skills of straight-line riding, stopping, shifting & turning, gradually progressing to swerving & emergency braking. Motorcycles are provided for students enrolled in the Basic Rider Course. If you are an automatic scooter rider, you can bring your own scooter with proof of insurance if its less than 500cc, 400lbs or less, in good working condition & registered as a motorcycle.

Classroom Topics Include:

- Protective Riding gear
- Preparation
- Risk Management
- Street Strategies & Special Riding situations
- Impairment
- Clutch & throttle control
- Straight-line riding
- Turning, Shifting, Stopping



To receive your motorcycle endorsement, you must:

- Complete the 3 hour e-course & bring proof of completion to the 1st day of class.
- Be at least 15 years old by the 1st day of class.
- If you are under 18, you are required to have a valid driver's permit or license and bring a parent or guardian to class to sign the waiver. If you pass the course, you will receive course completion cards to allow you to take the motorcycle permit and skills at a state exam station.
- If you are 18 years or older, you must bring a valid motorcycle permit to class each day. Expired permits are accepted if they have been expired for less than one year.
- You must attend the entire course. If you are late, you will be dismissed and forfeit your registration fee.

****Students must provide their own protective gear****

- DOT approved helmet
- Eye protection (sun glasses, eye glasses, or if your helmet has a full-face shield that will work)
- Full-fingered gloves (gardening gloves, winter gloves, etc.)
- Long sleeve shirt or jacket
- Long pants with no tears or holes
- Boots that cover the ankles
- Rain gear is highly recommended. Class will be held rain or shine.
